

KAKURO Use the numbers 1 through 9 to fill in the white squares in each grid such that:

1. The sum of the numbers in each horizontal partial row is given.
2. The sum of the numbers in each vertical partial column is given.
3. Within each sum, a number may NOT be repeated. Unlike Sudoku, a number MAY be repeated in any row or column if it is a part of two different sums. For example, "7" could appear 2 or 3 times in Row 1.
